

Synopsis of Magic Wanda and the Sculptor

Come and join Magic Wanda and her friends on their most recent adventure, as they discover sculpture!

This book tells the story of four dragons: Magic Wanda, Richie, Baz and Nubinu, discovering sculpture by rescuing a dream from the Dream Dump on Nimbi Island and delivering it back to the Sculptor in People Land. The Sculptor's dream was about making a cow out of wood and papier-mâché for the sculpture park he is creating for the children in his village. The dragons join him and discover what sculpture is all about.

Inspired by their activities with the Sculptor, the dragons make a giant sun sculpture for Nimbi Island. At the end of the book there are easy to follow instructions for children on how to make a sun sculpture of their own.

The DVD continues the theme of the book by showing a boy and his family discovering sculpture in St Ives. This includes a visit to The Barbara Hepworth Museum and the creation of a Magic Wanda sand sculpture on the beach by the world-famous sand sculptor, Andrew Baynes, who shares some of the secrets of his craft.

The DVD also contains two songs for children to sing and dance to, as well as the story from the book, which is narrated by Fenella Fielding.

Magic Wanda will build into a series of eight books, with accompanying DVDs. The first book is Magic Wanda and the Sculptor, which is due to be published in Spring 2005.
