“We come from Nimbi Island in the sky,” said Wanda. “That’s where dreams are made and where they return when you forget them.”

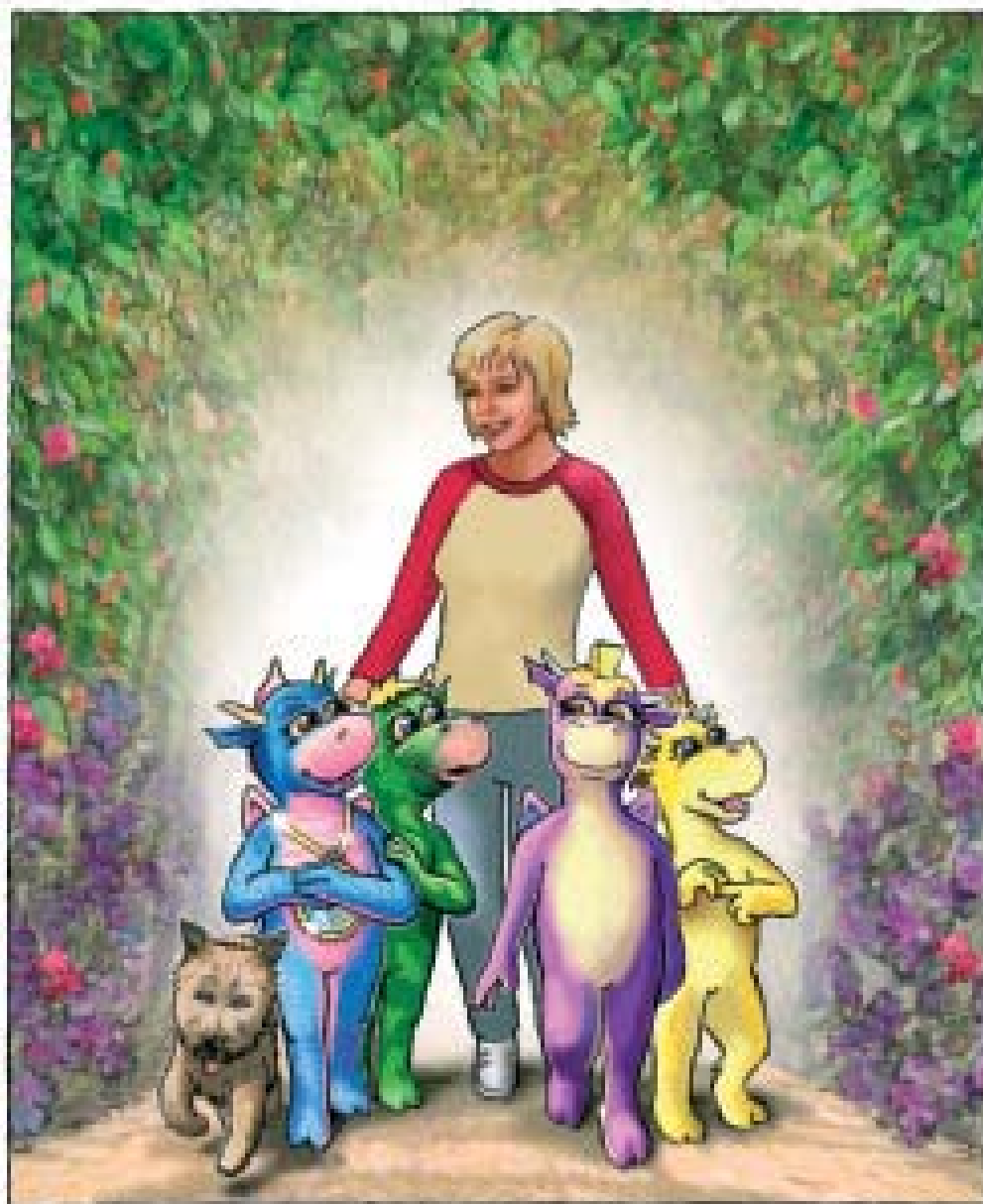
“We’ve brought your dream back,” said Baz.

The dragons followed her into the shop and out through an archway of sweet peas and runner beans and into...

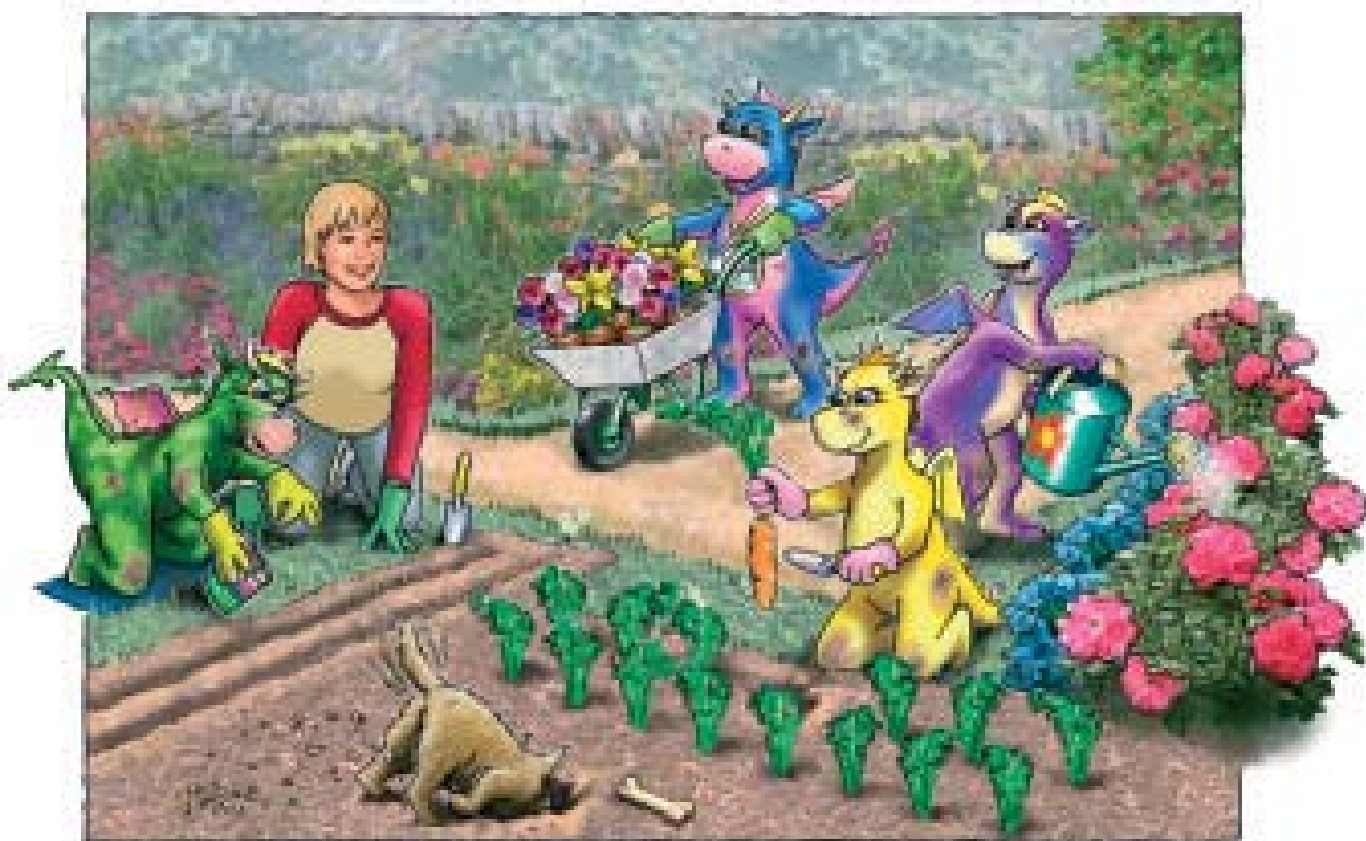
...Lily's beautiful garden.
